- EOC Eligible Courses** are approved by WCSD Office of Academics and the NDE before July 1 for the following school year. To be eligible to take an EOC exam, students must be enrolled in the EOC eligible course or the transcript must show prior completion of the course. Record of passing the course must be documented in the student information system, Infinite Campus.
- Cohort 2016 /5th Year Seniors** are required to participate in the College and Career Readiness (CCR) assessment and pass all four sections of the High School Proficiency Examination (HSPE).
- Grade 10 only, Spring 2017**, will participate in a general high school science exam to comply with 20 U.S.C. § 6311(b)(2). Not required for graduation. Eligibility determined by grade level only (all grade 10 participate); alternate test takers exempt (take the NAA in science).
